COME TO CLASS READY TO DANCE!

A dress code teaches students discipline, helping with overall focus and energy. By "dressing the part," dancers feel like dancers. When taking a dance class, students are asked to wear a leotard and tights with hair in a bun for ballet or secured neatly out of the face. Form-fitting dancewear is also a requirement for all jazz or lyrical classes. Adding & accessorizing to the dress code is permitted while keeping your class style in mind. Being properly dressed shows the teacher you are serious about your art form.

Jazz & Hip Hop: Black jazz shoes/sneakers & black knee pads

Ballet: Pink tights, black leotard preferred & pink slippers

Lyrical / Modern: Half sole shoes or footundeez

Acrobatics: Footless tights & bare feet

Tap: Black tap shoes

Broadway: Black jazz shoes.

Combination Classes: As needed, convertible tights for acrobatics, black knee pads & jazz shoes for jazzy hip hop, tap shoes, pink ballet slippers

Boys Hip Hop: Comfortable fitnesswear. Sneakers

ENROLLMENT

1. Register online, by mail, or walk in.
2. Submit registration fee, \$20.00 per student.
3. Pay first month tuition.
4. Be an informed parent by reading this brochure.

When you enroll a child with us, during our dance season (September through June) his/her class attendance is strongly encouraged; therefore, in general, tuition will not be pro-rated for missed classes. If your child is unable to attend a class, tuition is still due in order to reserve his/her spot in the class.

TUITION

Tuition is charged by the month, and is due in advance by the 7th of each month. Please remember that the monthly payment is not related to the number of classes in any given month. The number of classes each month depends on the calendar and any holidays that may take place during that month. Since each month is different, some months will have 3 classes; others will have 4 or 5 classes. Everything balances out over the course of the dance year. Please check our Holiday Schedule, as posted.

Payment methods include:

Online credit / debit, check, or cash.

VISA, MC, DISCOVER, AMERICAN EXPRESS,
AUTO PAYMENTS

There will be no credits and/or refunds for classes missed due to holiday, vacation, illness, weather, etc. Make-up lessons, when necessary, can be discussed. You must contact the office any time your child adds or drops a class so your account can be updated accordingly. If you drop a class and do not notify the office, your account will still be charged a full month's tuition. Monthly tuition pays for the reservation of the class rather than the actual attendance.
