How to Become a Participant

Each participant is required to purchase their own costumes and submit a Production fee. These charges are necessary to defray the cost involved when putting on a professional show at the Redding Civic Auditorium. Each performing class will need only (1) costume. Students will need to provide their own tights and dance shoes. All participants will need to attend additional practices at the Redding Civic Auditorium on Thursday and/or Friday during the week prior to the show. As we get closer to this date, a schedule will be posted letting you know your classes performing status.

EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT

All costumes are \$65.00 each if payment is received by December 20, 2019.

*CHECKS WILL NOT BE DEPOSITED UNTIL JANUARY 14, 2020..

After this date orders will incur an additional \$10.00 charge per costume until our late order has been placed on February 27, 2020.

After this date all costumes will be a Special Order at \$85.00 per costume with no guarantee. We will call to check availability.

Each participant is required to pay a \$45.00 Production Fee by March 1, 2020.
